

Product guide: Contempo Brazilian Slate

Appearance: In all natural stone there will be variations in colour tones, shades

and natural markings and they can display blemishes, veining and minor chips. These are natural characteristics and enhance the uniqueness of the product. We always recommend viewing the product before making a decision. You can do this at our indoor and outdoor show areas. We can supply full size samples for an additional cost to help give an impression of how your finished

project will look.

We regret that we cannot refund or exchange products, once they

have been installed, on the basis of texture, colour variation or

other natural occurring characteristics.

Installation: We recommend that all natural stone is laid on a full mortar bed.

Contempo Brazilian Slate should have an SBR bond slurry mix or similar applied to the underside of the slab to help with adhering to

the mortar.

Contempo Brazilian Slate should not be butt jointed. We

recommend a minimum joint width of 5mm.

Maintenance: We offer a range of sealers and cleaners you can use yourself.
